Difference Between Guided Reading and Close Reading ...

Guided highlighted reading. Purpose: Engage students in print Develop fluent scanning Highlight most important information Prepare text for substantive conversation Materials: A copy of the text A highlighter pen Planning: Select an article or piece of text that is accessible to all the students.

Pay close attention the titles and subtitles and read the segments without marking your pages at all. Highlight on the second reading. The second time you read your text, you should be prepared to identify the sentences that contain main points.
