Differentiated Instruction To manage effectively the differentiation of process, teachers need to employ a range of instructional strategies (Tomlinson, 1999), such as: Setting up stations in the classroom where different learners can work simultaneously on various tasks. Such stations naturally invite flexible grouping.

It is important to recognize that differentiated instruction is an approach to teaching, not simply a collection of strategies or activities. Effective differentiation requires ongoing evaluation of students' needs and conscious attention to designing instructional activities and assessment to meet those needs.

As with all my differentiated instruction worksheets, this can be applied to most stories.
