2. Use your fingers to probe the chest area of the pig. You should be able to feel the hard sternum (breastbone) and the tiny ridges of the ribcage. Keep moving down until you feel the bottom edge of the rib cage; this is where the diaphragm separates the thoracic cavity from the abdominal cavity.

Put the fetal pig onto a separate dissection tray. Use a tray large enough to fit the fetal pig. Usually a 10 in × 12 in (25 cm × 30 cm) or larger tray will do the trick. Set the pig down on its side in the center of the tray. Fetal pig dissection kits can be purchased online for as low as \$29.95 USD.

Carefully lay the pig on one side in your dissecting pan and cut away the skin from the side of the face and upper neck to expose the masseter muscle that works the jaw, lymph nodes, and salivary glands. The salivary glands kind of look like chewing gum and are often lost if you cut too deeply.
